


ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CASE STUDY



CHALLENGE

In addition, a communication plan was adopted to ensure that if there were any changes to the materials needed, Walker could quickly provide alternatives, make changes to the schedule, or find a solution from our vast portfolio of products.
